(Proposed by Act No. 2010-226)	<b>PROPOSED LOCAL AMENDMENT NUMBER THREE (3)</b> Relating to Baldwin County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that only county-owned solid waste landfills may be used for the disposal of garbage, household waste, industrial solid waste, and solid waste; to exempt certain existing contracts, on-site and industrial permit holders, and the disposal of certain inert debris and construction materials from the proposed amendment; to provide that the county may not charge established gate rates exceeding the rates for similar services charged by public and private solid waste landfill operators in surrounding counties; to provide for violations to the amendment; to authorize local laws for the implementation and administration of the provisions of the amendment; and to provide that the amendment and any local law implementing the amendment automatically shall terminate three years following the ratification of the constitutional amendment unless extended by local act with unanimous vote of the members of the Baldwin County Legislative Delegation. <b>PROPOSED AMENDMENTS WHICH APPLY TO THE STATE AT LARGE</b> <b>PROPOSED STATEWIDE AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE (1)</b> Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that the provision in Amendment 778, now appearing as Section 269.08 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, which prohibits the payment of any fees, charges, or commissions for the assessment and collection of any special ad valorem tax on taxable property levied by the county commission pursuant to Amendment 778 (Section 269.08) shall only apply to any ad valorem tax first levied and collected pursuant to Amendment 778 (Section 269.08) for the tax year commencing October 1, 2006.
