CERTIFICATION OF VOTES

RECOUNT FOR CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE, PLACE 20,
 NOVEMBER 23, 2010.

JEFFERSON COUNTY, ALABAMA

Of the 184 precincts, (which includes Birmingham Absentee, Bessemer Absentee, and provisional Ballots) in Jefferson County, Alabama, the results are as follows:

CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE, PLACE 20

AGNES CHAPPELL	102,293
JULIE A. PALMER	102,981

There were six (6) precincts which left some of their voted ballots in voting machines on election night. The voted ballots were discovered when Jefferson County election personnel transported the locked machines to the Jefferson County Elections Division facility within one to two days following the General Election.

Alabama Attorney General’s Opinion number 2005-022 states that,

“Voted ballots included in the election night results that were left inside locked voting machines on election night by poll workers and were discovered and secured by election machine custodians following the election should be counted in the recount and added to the recount totals, as long as these ballots and the vote totals are accounted for separately from the remainder of the recount totals.”

Ballots left in locked voting machines at the precincts in Jefferson County, Alabama, on election night, and retrieved by election machine custodians after the election, totaled as follows:


